- The Rio Tinto bauxite mining operations on the Gove Peninsula are expected to finish by 2030, unlocking enormous development potential in the region. We work across the local ecosystem to enable sustainable jobs and enterprises in the region.
- Our work is guided by the local regional economic growth plan and the aspirations of Traditional Owners and communities about what the future of the region looks like.
- DEAL is situated in Nhulunbuy, working across the East Arnhem region and is uniquely positioned to facilitate investment opportunities that grow and strengthen local jobs and the economy.

The region is steeped in Yolŋu history, culture and songlines, making it one of the most culturally special and significant places in Australia. Yolŋu Traditional Owners have a strong vision and aspiration for the region, keeping towns, communities and homelands strong and enhancing economic development.

- Many industries are growing their business in the region, from agribusiness and tourism to space research – make East Arnhem home for your business growth. We are the front door to facilitate your investment.






Our mission and vision

With the foundations established, our focus will be on continuing to accelerate opportunities for sustainable growth and enhancing liveability and wellbeing across the region. We will be:

- working closely with Yolnu leaders and other key stakeholders to identify priority activities to drive regional economic development
- collaborating with relevant stakeholders to identify economic opportunities and leverage private and public sector investment across East Arnhem (including ongoing engagement and support for the Regional Economic Growth Plan and Gove Peninsula Futures Reference Group)
- connecting regional businesses and industry sectors with international trade partners, financial markets, and potential investors
- providing independent advice to all levels of government on critical issues affecting economic development across East Arnhem

The transition of East Arnhem from mining dependence unlocks the potential for growth in the region, with strong, resilient communities.
