# East Arnhem business – your chance to comment on draft National Regional and Remote Transport Strategy

2 June 2015

The Northern Territory Government is leading a national process to develop a comprehensive strategy that focuses on improving transport infrastructure opportunities in remote and regional areas.

Minister for Transport Peter Chandler said the draft National Remote and Regional Transport Strategy was now open for public consultation, following its release by the Transport and Infrastructure Council.

“The Strategy will aim to improve services to allow for better access to employment, education, health services and economic opportunities across remote and regional areas,” Mr Chandler said.

Territorians and stakeholders across Australia are encouraged to provide input into the draft strategy by 31 July 2015.

“It is important that East Arnhem Land is part of the conversation when remote and regional transport strategies are being considered and the format of this strategy makes it very easy for local enterprises to indicate our transport priorities” said CEO of Developing East Arnhem Limited, Carley Scott.

A final strategy is expected to be considered by the Transport and Infrastructure Council in November 2015 along with an implementation plan that supports the Strategy’s delivery.
